## Doverbrook Pool Rules Pool Hours: 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

## There is no lifeguard on duty at any time

## You must leave by closing time. Your card will not open the gate after 8:00 p.m.

- 1. All owners/residents must use their own access fob to open the gate. One (1) FOB is issued per unit/residence. Residents are prohibited from "loaning" their access fob to **anyone**.
- 2. Guests must be accompanied by an owner/resident at all times. Each unit is limited to a maximum of (3) three guests at any time during any pool visit.
- 3. Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult member of the household.
- 4. Any persons with open wounds, band aids, bandages, or communicable diseases are not allowed in the pool.
- 5. All owners/residents and all guests must take a cleansing shower before entering the pool.
- 6. All Swimmers must wear proper bathing suits. Cut offs, gym shorts or any other non-bathing suit articles of clothing are not allowed.
- 7. Any persons with shoulder length hair must use a bathing cap or tie their hair back while swimming.
- 8. Diapers are not allowed in the pool.
- 9. Swimmies, wings, tubes and bubbles are allowed to be used by non-swimmers. A parent or adult member of the household must be in the pool at all times with non-swimmers.
- 10. Only flotation devices provided by the association are allowed in the pool.
- 11. Alcoholic beverages, drugs, and glass containers are prohibited in the pool area.
- 12. Smoking, including the use of "e" cigarettes and/or vaping devices, is not allowed in or around the pool area.
- 13. Any violation of the Association Poll Rules will result in the immediate restriction of pool access to all residents associated with the unit and corresponding access FOB.
