# Water Usage

In a continuing effort to control expenses associated with water usage at the property, the Association continues to offer assistance to homeowners by helping them correct one of the most wasteful water problems in any home...leaking toilet flappers. **FREE** toilet flappers continue to be available at the Doverbrook Office. Homeowners are responsible for the proper installations of the flapper.

We would also continue to suggest that all unit owners make sure there are no drips/leaks from any of your faucets (bathroom, kitchen & outside faucets); limit the time you spend taking a shower; schedule the cycles of your water-based appliances (dishwasher & washing machines) with usage in mind; utilize the discounted Golden Nozzle car wash tickets available in the office rather than washing your vehicle on site; follow the Association water schedule for grass/flowers (6:00am—9:00am or 6:00pm—9:00pm **ONLY**). If you suspect any problems exist with your unit's plumbing, contact a license & insured plumber.

# **Maintenance or Emergency Calls**

Please call **593-5515** for all after hour or emergency calls. All **emergency calls** will be forwarded to our maintenance staff and they will contact you as soon as possible. An emergency is considered to be something that cannot wait until the following morning or Monday morning if such should occur over the weekend. Additionally, in many instances, an emergency pertains to elements that are the sole responsibility of the unit owner (i.e. hot water tank leak, non-working furnace, broken or leaking unit plumbing). In these cases owners should contact the appropriate contractor for service. **Non-emergency calls** will be forwarded to the Doverbrook office and will be responded to during the next business day. Do not call Plotkin for emergencies.
